- a. Challenge Day

  - vii. Students have been prepped with information about Challenge Day in their Irish Time this week and last.
  - viii. Teachers will be trained next Wednesday during staff PD time.
  - ix. Do we need an all-school debriefing assembly following Challenge Day?
