Restrictions:

1. For four year College students, it pays the institution after successful (2.0 or better GPA) completion of the first term of post-secondary work, and registration for a second term.
2. For Community College and Trade School students, the money will be sent to their institution when the Lincoln County Foundation receives evidence of registration for the first term.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. Pays after successful completion of a term of post-secondary work and registration for a second term and may be renewable.

F.LEE BARCLAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

1 @ \$1,000.00 for a Waldport High School graduating senior.

Criteria:

1. Graduating senior from Waldport High School who has attended WHS for at least two years with a 3.25 or higher GPA.
2. Whenever possible proof of acceptance to a 2 or 4 year Oregon College or University. Enrollment in a Community College must show plans leading to a 4 year degree.
3. Priority to students planning a career in Forestry Management, Teaching, Civil or Forest Engineering, Agriculture or Animal or Veterinary Science.
4. Demonstrate outstanding commitment to Community Service, Leadership and Academic Achievement with details in their resume concerning specific roles and responsibilities during leadership roles. Community service activities should include specific activities and/or duties, hours, articles made and/or donated and or money earned (if applicable), and who benefited from the activity
5. One page essay addressing Career choice, reasons for choosing that career and any activities you have pursued or explored in preparation for that career.
6. Financial need is **NOT** a factor.

Restrictions:

1. Scholarship pays immediately on notice of registration for the first term.

LINCOLN COUNTY MASTER GARDENER ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Lincoln County Master Gardener Association (LCMGA) is a service organization supporting the Oregon State University (OSU) Extension Service Master Gardener Program and dedicated to educating and supporting Lincoln County residents by providing leadership in the use of effective and environmentally responsible horticultural techniques. The scholarship is intended to finance the student's higher education expenses. Payment will be made directly to the learning institution in the fall of each year.

1 @ \$1000.00, with three year renewal option, available to graduating seniors of all LCSD High Schools, sponsored by Lincoln County Master Gardener Association.

CRITERIA:

1. Must be a resident of Lincoln County
2. Must be a graduating senior from a Lincoln County high school, or
3. A student home-schooled in Lincoln County, or
4. A student who graduated from a Lincoln County high school in the last five years of date of application
5. Must be accepted into an accredited institution of higher learning such as a community college, a college, or university.
6. Must be a student's first secondary degree.

APPLICATION WILL INCLUDE:

1. Lincoln County Foundation application form.
2. High school transcript to include first semester of senior year or, if applicant has graduated, a complete transcript.
3. Resume including: important academic courses and workshops, sports and other activities, honors and awards, work- study programs and internships, community service, employment skills.
4. Two letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from school person
 - b. One from a member
5. A typed essay of no more than 500 words explaining how your choice of academic pursuits would reflect the purpose of Lincoln County Master Gardener Association: the LCMGA is a service organization supporting the Oregon State University (OSU) Extension Service Master Gardener Program and dedicated to educating and supporting Lincoln County residents by providing leadership in the use of effective and environmentally responsible horticultural techniques.

The scholarship may be funded for three additional years, provided the following conditions are met:

1. Student remains in good standing with the institution
2. A copy of current transcript is submitted prior to funds being released to the school
3. Funds must be used within five years of date of award

If recipient changes majors, LCMBA requires an additional essay on how the new choice of academic pursuits reflects the purpose of LCMGA
