Scholars Program

The Laurance Family Foundation scholarship program grants four year college scholarships to highly qualified low income students. The scholarships are normally four year scholarships that provide varying amounts of funding per year depending upon a student's needs. The following outlines the information that an applicant should provide.

1. High School or College transcripts.
2. All SAT and ACT scores.
3. Personal essay telling the applicants story and also describing the applicant's goals for college and career. The essay is the most important part of the application and needs to tell the applicants story fully and truthfully. The applicant should use the essay to show the reasons why the Foundation should select them. The Foundation looks for applicants that have proven that they can work hard to reach their goals and have proven that they can achieve high marks in their school work. The Foundation also looks for applicants that have strong character and are honest and reliable and considerate of others. Finally, the Foundation looks for applicants that have clear career goals and are pursuing a program that will lead to a degree that will allow the applicant to earn a good living and be financially independent.
4. A brief description of how the applicant plans to fund the costs of college including any scholarships they may have been granted or any federal or state aid that they may have been awarded.
5. A copy of the last two years of their parent's tax returns.
6. Proof of US Citizenship or explanation of current status in the USA.
7. The application should include the applicant's phone number, email address and a recent photo.
