Dear Student and Parent(s):

At Oregon Coast Community College, we believe it is important to invest in the talented youth of our community. We are again offering our Oregon Coast Scholars Program, a scholarship program for Lincoln County students graduating from Lincoln County High Schools in June 2021 with a grade point average of 3.5 or higher. The Scholars Program provides a full-tuition scholarship for up to two years at Oregon Coast Community College.

The Oregon Coast Scholars Program has been made possible by the Oregon Coast Community College Foundation, a hard-working group of volunteers that raises money for scholarships and College programs. The scholarship covers tuition for full-time attendance. It does not cover books and fees or online classes other than those offered by OCCC.

The criteria and application process for the Oregon Coast Scholars Program are simple. Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who meet the following criteria:

Eligibility Requirements for high school students

- Attend high school in Lincoln County.
- Earn a cumulative, unweighted GPA of 3.5 or better (as of the first semester grades of the final year in high school).
- Be on track to earn a regular high school diploma (students with modified diplomas are ineligible).
- Enroll full-time (12-18 credits) at Oregon Coast the fall term that immediately follows high school graduation.

Eligibility Requirements for home-schooled students

- Reside permanently within Lincoln County, Oregon.
- Earn ACT composite score of 27 **or** SAT Reasoning Test combined score of 1200 in Critical Reading and Mathematics.
- Enroll full-time (12-18 credits) at Oregon Coast the fall term immediately after completing high school requirements.

Eligibility Requirements for Military Veterans

- Meet requirements above for either high school students or home-schooled students.
- Joined the military within three months of graduating from high school or completing high school requirements.
- Enroll full-time (12-18 credits) at Oregon Coast within six months of military discharge.

Applications must be received by Oregon Coast Community College before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 7, 2021. An Oregon Coast Scholars Application Packet is enclosed. Late applications will not be considered.
